IB Learner Profile

The International Baccalaureate® (IB) learner profile describes a broad range of human capacities and responsibilities that go beyond academic success. They imply a commitment to help all members of the school community learn to respect themselves, others and the world around them. Each of the IB's programs is committed to the development of students according to the IB learner profile.

The learner profile is comprised of 10 attributes that are emphasized by IB World Schools. These attributes have been deemed necessary to help students become responsible members of local, national, and global communities.

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Success Bound

Success Bound is a curriculum for middle grade students to explore their identities and futures, expanding their outlook on postsecondary opportunities. The Success Bound curriculum emphasizes a holistic approach to the learning and development of students.
