Illinois Postsecondary and Career Expectations (PaCE)

At the middle school and early high school level, the Illinois Postsecondary and Career Expectations (PaCE) Framework is designed to provide students with guided exploration of postsecondary planning and options in a manner that is consistent with adolescent development. Meaningful participation in postsecondary preparation programs requires that students perceive college and/or career as possible and probable. Too often, programs are designed to serve only students who already have a college-going or career-oriented identity. The developmental work in the middle school framework is intended to prepare students to more fully engage with the PaCE Framework throughout the critical high school years.

Success Bound

Success Bound is a curriculum for middle grade students to explore their identities and futures, expanding their outlook on postsecondary opportunities. The Success Bound curriculum includes an entire unit dedicated to college and career exploration, and skills for postsecondary readiness are woven throughout all units and grade levels. The chart below demonstrates how Success Bound lessons align with the three key domains of the Illinois PaCE Middle School Framework: Aspiration, Planning, and Self-Advocacy. Using the Success Bound curriculum in its entirety, or by choosing select lessons, is one way to meet the state <u>legislative mandate</u> to adopt and begin implementation of career exploration and deveopment activites aligned to a PaCE framework for grades 6-12 by July 2, 2025.
